Malmo Hall Rental Information

- Hall Rentals are available ONLY to Malmo Community League Members. You must have a current membership number before you can rent.
- You must be 21 years of age or older to rent.
- Damage deposit must be a cheque for \$500.00 made out to Malmo Community League. This cheque will be returned once the hall has been inspected for damages and the key is returned.
- A contract and a list of responsibilities must be signed by the renter upon receiving the key.
- Anyone using the hall and serving liquor MUST HAVE Third Party Liability Insurance, as well as a Liquor Permit. Without these items your rental will be CANCELLED, when you come to pick up the hall key. You must be able to show proof that these items have been purchased.
- Before going into the hall and setting up for whatever reason, please check with me to make sure the hall is free from other rentals. Your consideration is appreciated.

MALMO COMMUNITY LEAGUE WINTER PROGRAMS - CITY OF EDMONTON INSTRUCTOR LED

The morning of January 10, 2009 the rink was full of enthusiastic little skaters. **The Learn to Skate program for 3 - 5 years olds** started off the excitement. The full class of 13 children enjoyed



their first lesson on a bright, sunny, warm day. Two young instructors, from the City of Edmonton, introduced the children to some basic skating skills.

Next up was another full class of **6 - 9 year olds** eager to take on their first **Learn to Skate** lesson. Seeing



the group learning to fall and get up was like watching others frolicking and sliding along a frozen river, a sight that would bring a smile onto anyone's face! After each class hot chocolate and coffee was enjoyed by both participants and parents.



The energy at the rink didn't stop there. A group of six stoked **6 - 12 year old** boys took to the rink all geared up for **Learn to Play Hockey**. The City of Edmonton instructor, with whistle in hand, took to the ice and worked the boys with some drills that focused on skating, stick handling, passing and receiving the puck. After the grueling two hours, the boys took pleasure in a cup of hot chocolate.



All three of the Winter Programs will run each Saturday with the last class being held on Feb. 21/09. The Jan. 17 class had to be cancelled due to the extreme cold weather Mother Nature dealt out that day, but the following week classes were back on track! Please note that classes will not be held Feb. 7 due to the family, fun-filled Winter Carnival. Classes will resume the following week.

I would like to send out a big Thank You to the other community members who have come out to use the rink and have respected the requirements and have given the ice space needed to help make these community programs a success.

CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING. This program was held for community members on Sunday, January 18/09. The warm day made the snow quite sticky, but 6 people made it out and took advantage of the program provided through the River Valley Outdoor



Centre. An instructor brought out all equipment and got each individual set up with boots, skis, and poles. Basic skills were introduced which included an awkward, but quite hilarious way to get back up on your skis after a fall. With legs waving up in the air while laying on backs brought thoughts of a turtle trying to flip over to mind! Gliding skills were practiced and reinforced by racing and playing games. Once everyone was comfortable on their 'new feet' the instructor broke trail and we all skied around the school field. The young participants soon realized being at the end of the line was beneficial. Our small group got a good work-out, introduced to Cross-Country Skiing in a safe environment, and all had a lot of fun! Thanks everyone for coming out.
